Frequency of CAC Meetings: Worth 40% of final score

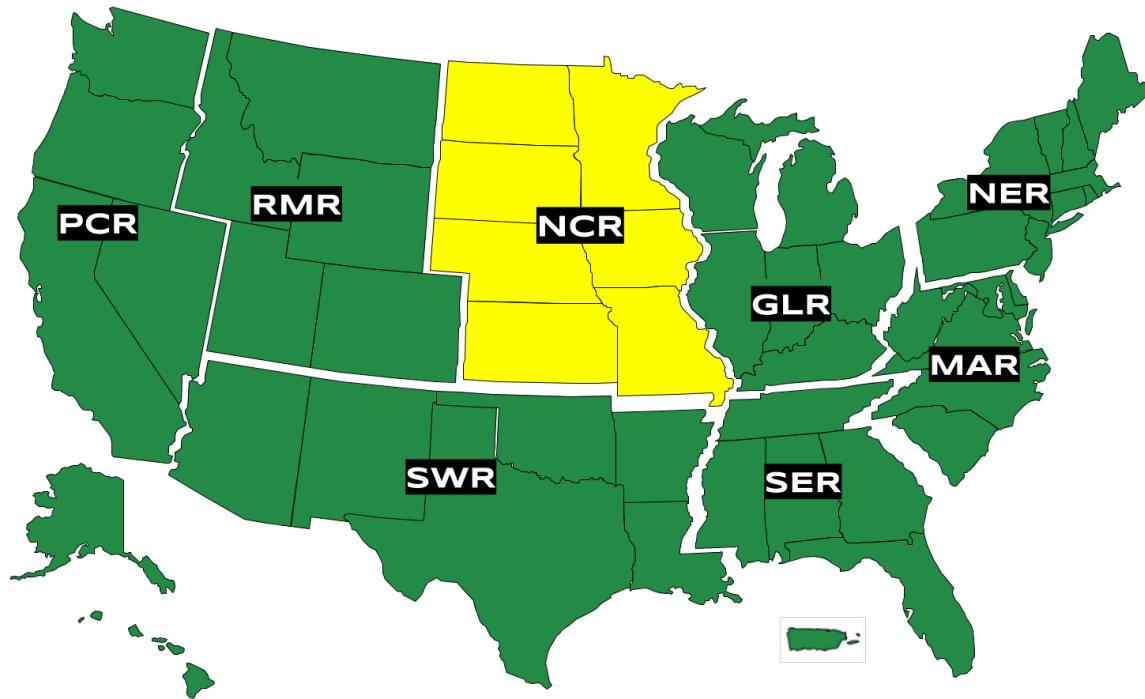
Percentage of CAC is Active: Worth 40% of final score

Level of Senior Member Involvement/Guidance Within the Council: Worth 20% of final score

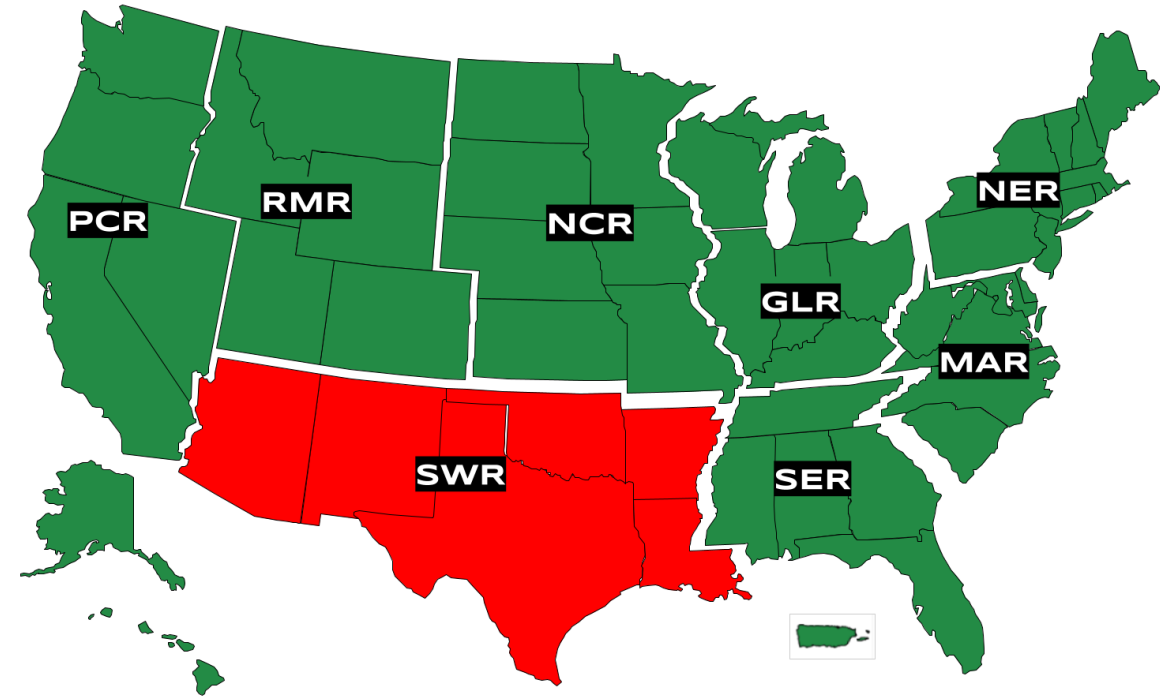


CAC Status Nationwide (Region CACs)

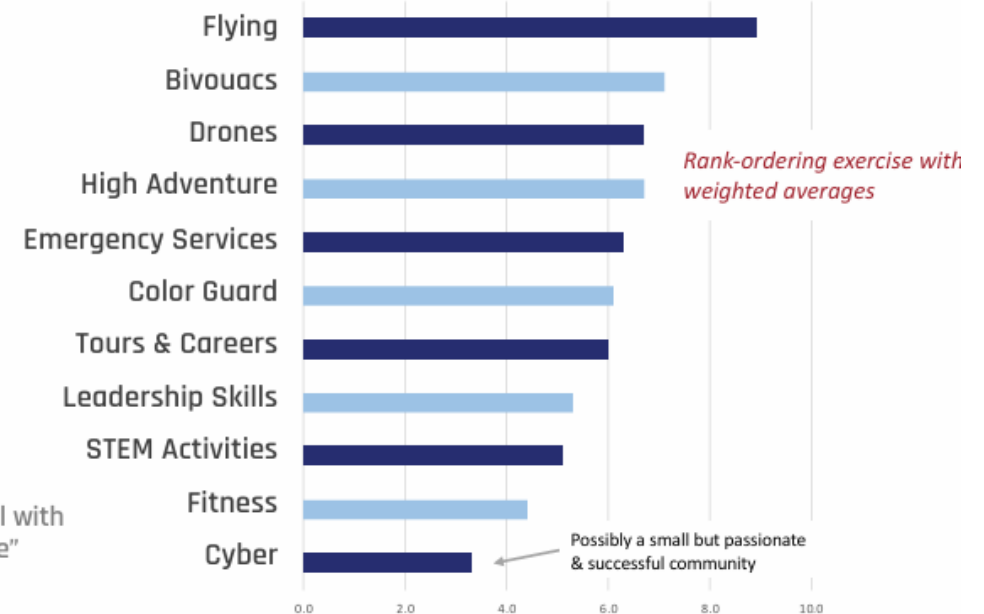
